## *Booking terms and conditions*

---

1. A non-refundable deposit of £500 is required to guarantee your chosen date and as confirmation. An invoice will be dispatched following receipt of a completed booking form and signed terms & conditions.
2. A meeting six to eight weeks prior to your wedding is required. This is in order to finalise the programming and details of your day.
3. An invoice will be sent to you eight weeks prior to your wedding date for 75% of the cost, with the remaining balance due four weeks later.
4. All prices are current and subject to VAT (excluding food and drink prices)

In the event of the need for postponement or cancellation, the following will apply:

Postponement – your deposit will be carried forward for a future date. The Pavilion will endeavour to re-let the particular released date/dates.

Cancellation – if the booking is cancelled, the deposit will be lost. We advise all clients to take out wedding insurance.

## *Civil ceremonies*

---

Upon receipt of confirmation of your booking, the Pavilion will complete an 'Application for the Attendance of a Registrar' to notify the local office of your details. The local office will, in turn, contact the parties concerned.
